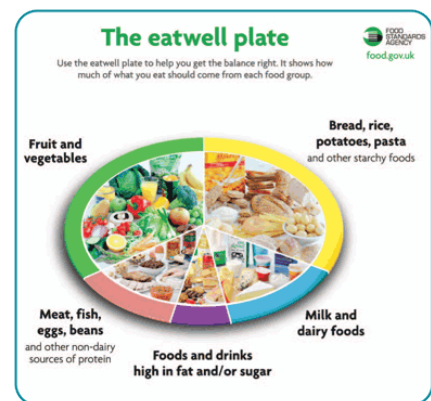
## PE Timetable
