PE Timetable


As PE has now started at Gorton Primary please could we remind parents that all children need to bring their PE kit to school. Each week we will send it home to be washed ready for the following lesson.

Congratulations to those all the children who won the Ozzy award this week for Adaptability.




In N2P the winners were Ava and Helena.
