Congratulations to those all the children who won the Ozzy award this week for Empathetic.

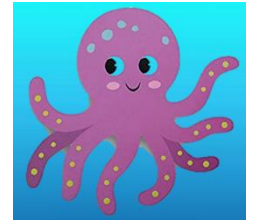


In N2P the winners were Affan and Rayan-Zaki.
