

'LEARN' words at THE PARK



Label



- Name it

Say what it is

Swing, Slide, Seesaw, Roundabout, Fence, Bike, Ball, Wellies, Grass, Tree, Flower, Butterfly





Say what you're 'doing' (whilst doing it) Sliding, Swinging, Jumping, Chasing, Riding



Comment on what your child is doing and how they are doing it, e.g. 'you are swinging high!'

Explore

- Talk about it

What we do with it

Bike: ride it Gate: open/close it Flower: smell it

The type of thing it is

Equipment, a vehicle, a toy, an animal...



What it looks like e.g.

Flower: Pretty, Red Tree: Big, Enormous Slide: Shiny, Long



What it feels like e.g. Slide: Cold, Hard Leaf: spiky, smooth Tree trunk: rough

Appreciate WOW!

- Enjoy words

Play word games:

- Copy my action: 'let's all jump... now let's leap. Shall we *jump* or leap?"
- Describing game: take it in turns to describe an object such as 'it has wheels, you sit on it, it moves' (bike)



Encourage your child to ask what new words mean

- Teach them that it's OK to ask what a word means - Look up the meaning of a word

together

Repeat



- Say it lots!

Use the same word many times to help vour child to remember it.

Use the word in **sentences** using repetition, e.g. "Jump to the gate" "Jump to the swing" "Jump to the slide"

Read books about the park Football at the Park



Sing the same song lots of times, e.g: "This is the way...we put on our wellies... we ride our bike... smell the flowers..."



New



- Add new words

Add brand new words

Sky, Ground, Bee, Wasp, Caterpillar, Beetle, Plant, Gate, Bench, Monkey bars

Use words that mean the same/ the opposite of a word they know, e.g:

- if they know 'running', then use 'jogging' or 'racing'
- If they know 'high', teach 'low'
